# NOTES REGARDING MEMBERSHIP OF THE LRRFC:

## THE LRRFC:

- is a Home Office Approved Club 1660960
- all new members are subject to a probationary period of 3 months
- under the terms of our Home Office approval the police will be notified:
  - members joining the LRRFC
  - o members renewing their membership with the LRRFC
  - $\circ$   $\hfill members who have not shot with the LRRFC in the past year$

## DATA PROTECTION:

- Details you provide will be held on computer.
- The LRRFC will never pass on your information to 3<sup>rd</sup> parties.
- Computer records relating to your membership will be retained for 6 years after membership ceases.

### **PHOTOGRAPHY:**

• The LRRFC may take photographs at any of our events for use in club journals, social media or promotion of the club.

### PROHIBITED PERSON - FIREARMS ACT SECTION 21:

(1) A person who has been sentenced to preventive detention, or to firearms by persons imprisonment or to corrective training for a term of three years or, previously convicted more or who has been sentenced to be detained for such a term in a of a crime young offenders' institution in Scotland, shall not at any time have a firearm or ammunition in his possession.

(2) A person who has been sentenced to borstal training, to corrective training for less than three years or to imprisonment for a term of three months or more but less than three years, or who has been sentenced to be detained for such a term in a detention centre or in a young offender's institution in Scotland, shall not at any time before the expiration of the period of five years from the date of his release have a firearm or ammunition in his possession.

(3) A person who:

(a) is the holder of licence issued under section 53 of the Children and Young Persons Act 1933 or section 57 of the Children and Young Persons (Scotland) Act 1937 (which sections provide for the detention of children and young persons convicted of serious crime, but enable them to be discharged on licence by the Secretary of State); or

(b) is subject to a recognizance to keep the peace or to be of good behaviour, a condition of which is that he shall not possess, use or carry a firearm, or is subject to a probation order containing a requirement that he shall not possess, use or carry a firearm; or (c) has, in Scotland, been ordained to find caution a condition of which is that he shall not possess, use or carry a firearm; shall not, at any time during which he holds the licence or is so subject or has been so ordained, have a firearm or ammunition in his possession.

JUNIOR MEMBERS:

- A junior member is defined as being between 14-18 years of age.
- Must be always accompanied by a parent or guardian, when attending LRRFC events.

### LRRFC RULES OF MEMBERSHIP:

- All members must abide by:
  - Range Orders created by the range operator.
  - Any supplementary Range Orders created by the LRRFC.
  - The club constitution.
  - Rules related to specific shooting discipline.
