



Sketch NTS

1. Take a piece of wallpaper at least 550mm long and about 150mm wide.
2. Draw a vertical centre line.
3. Paste a 25 yards black on the centre line near the bottom of the paper.
4. Measure 11mm up from centre line and mark minimum 50m elevation.
5. Measure 43mm up from centre line and mark minimum 100 yards elevation.
6. Measure 164mm up from centre line and mark minimum 200 yards elevation.
7. Measure 300mm up from centre line and mark minimum 300 yards elevation.
8. Measure 465mm up from centre line and mark minimum 400 yards elevation.

These figures work with a BSA Century and RWS R50 at about 20° C. Expect significant elevation changes with temperature. If you find your elevations at 25 yards to reach the figures listed above you should hit the target.

500 yards - Approximately 32 MOA above 400 yards
